“JUST LOOK UP”



Life is like playing in an orchestra. First, God gives us our instrument and some music, and we sit down to play. We say to God, we have never played this song before! We will never be able to do it!" But God gets up on the pedestal and holds His baton in His hand. He winks at us and says calmly, "Just look up and follow me, I will lead you." We decide that it doesn't matter what God says, we want to play an easier song. So, as He raises His baton and begins to conduct, we ignore Him and begin wailing away at the one we wanted to play. However, it just doesn't quite work. The music doesn't sound beautiful at all, because it's not the song God wanted us to play. After a little more playing and a whole lot more frustration, we realize that it would be better for us just to listen to our Conductor. So we silently search for the piece He wanted us to play. "But God, it looks so hard." God just smiles caringly and taps the baton on His stand. "Just look up and follow Me, and I will lead you," He whispers. So, we begin to play. In the beginning, it seems as though we will never be able to play the song that God has chosen for us. Then we remember what He said, so we look up and see God carefully counting out the beats for us, and if we listen carefully, we can hear His voice humming our part. Then we find that as long as our eyes are fixed on the Conductor, we are able to play along. Sure, some parts are really tough, but as long as we follow Him and listen to His steady rhythm, we can make it through. Remember, all we have to do is: Just look up and follow Him!
